Segment 9: Tulfes – Pertisau

If you're after lung-burning 1,500 meter uphill climbs and adrenaline-charged 1,500 meter descents, this intermediate to expert rated route is the place for you. The sections from Tulfes into Inntal Valley and from Jenbach to Pertisau will definitely test your strength. Undisputed highlight of this portion of the Tirol Mountain Bike Safari is riding along the magnificent lakeside road from Maurach to Pertisau, skirting the shores of Achensee Lake.

Tourdescription

Leave Tulfes eastwards on little used back roads. The route crosses two creek valleys above Weer. A long climb is followed by a steep and fast downhill into Inntal Valley. Cross the valley to get to its northern side and follow Inn Cycle Path to Jenbach. From the highway underpass the trail starts to climb towards Achensee Lake along lightly trafficked Bavarica Tyrolensis road, avoiding the heavily trafficked Achensee federal road. Continue cycling until you reach the village of Maurach and ride the lovely lakeside road to Pertisau.
